



After the dances, kids were provided some snacks. Each girl was given a cup and a pencil box as a parting gift. Beta has also donated ration for about 2 months to the organisation.

National Service Scheme (N.S.S) 'TORNA TREK 2018' ^{2nd} Sept 2018






