






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The 159th Birth Anniversary of Swami Vivekananda is celebrated all over the country giving a message to the youth the way of life and ideals that will make India a better country in future.






It was a learning and interactive session for the all girls students as well as faculty members where she answered all the queries put up by the students to their full satisfaction.






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

The staff members of MMCOE visited the Blood Donation camp to encourage the students and also few of them donated blood.



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
