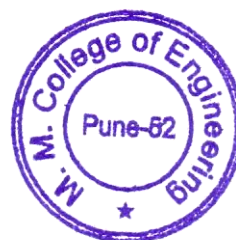

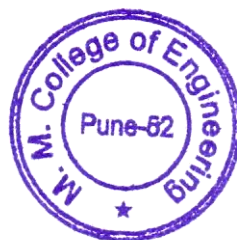

**Figure:** Annual Gender Sensitization Plan A.Y. 2020-21



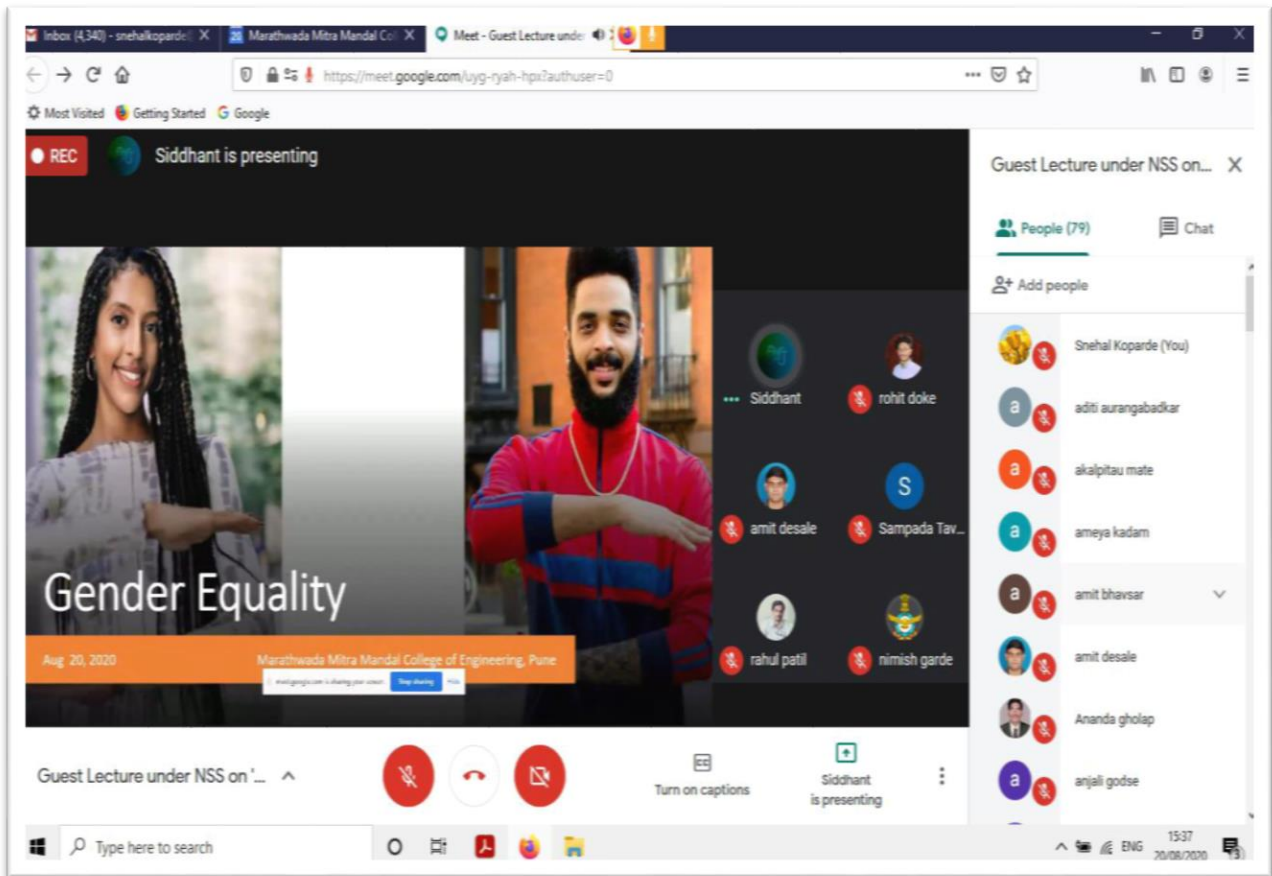

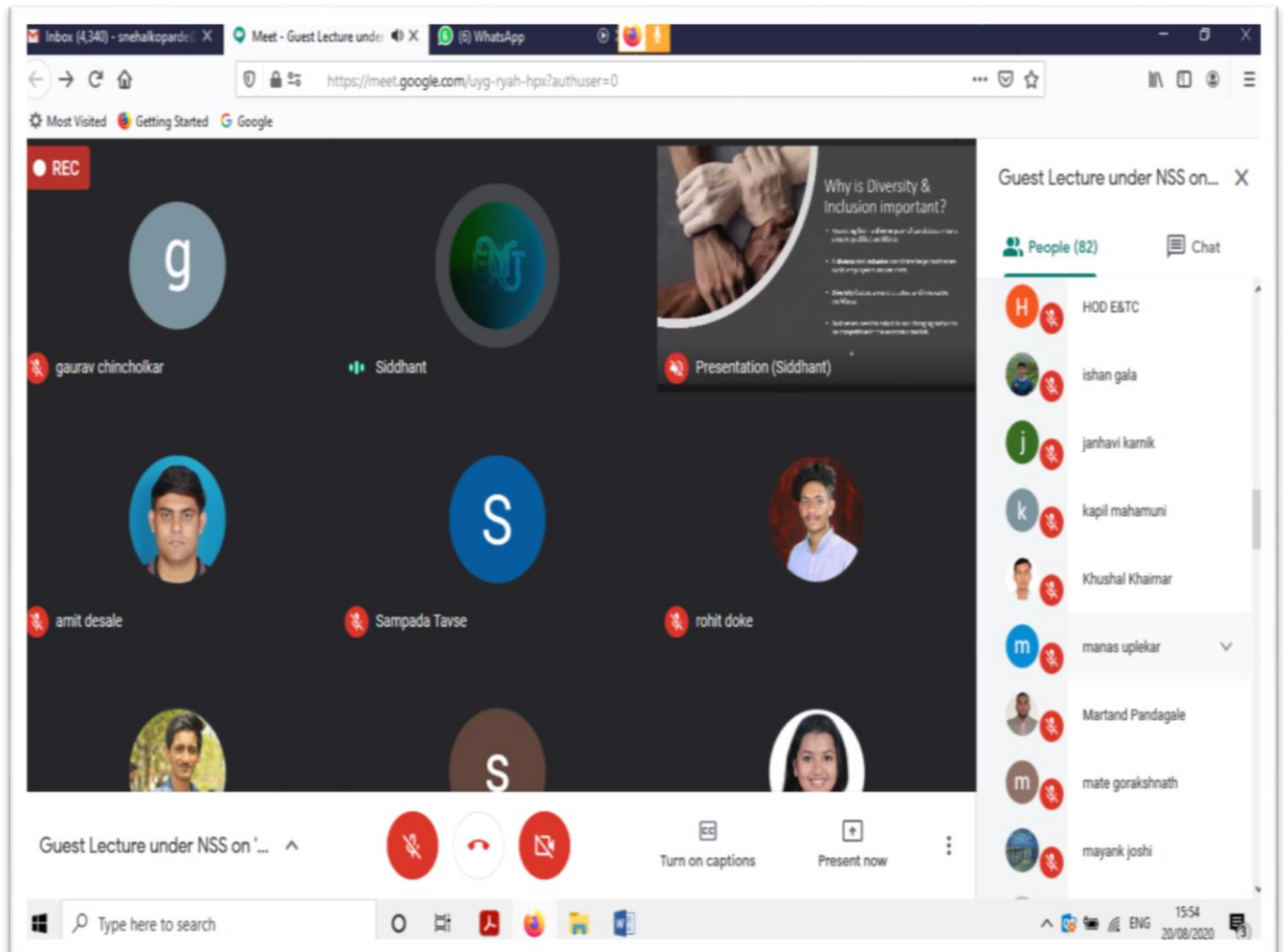



Report on your gender statistics transparently. Communicate this openly and honestly with your workforce, explaining the tangible progress you plan to make.
- 2. Support women into more senior roles**
- 3. Implement gender neutral recruitment processes**  
Carefully word your job adverts. Research shows that adjectives like 'competitive' and 'determined' put off women. On the other hand, words like 'collaborative' and 'cooperative' tend to attract more women than men. Standardize interviews, anonymize resumes and use blind evaluation processes.
- 4. Review salaries and standardize pay**
- 5. Provide training on unconscious bias**



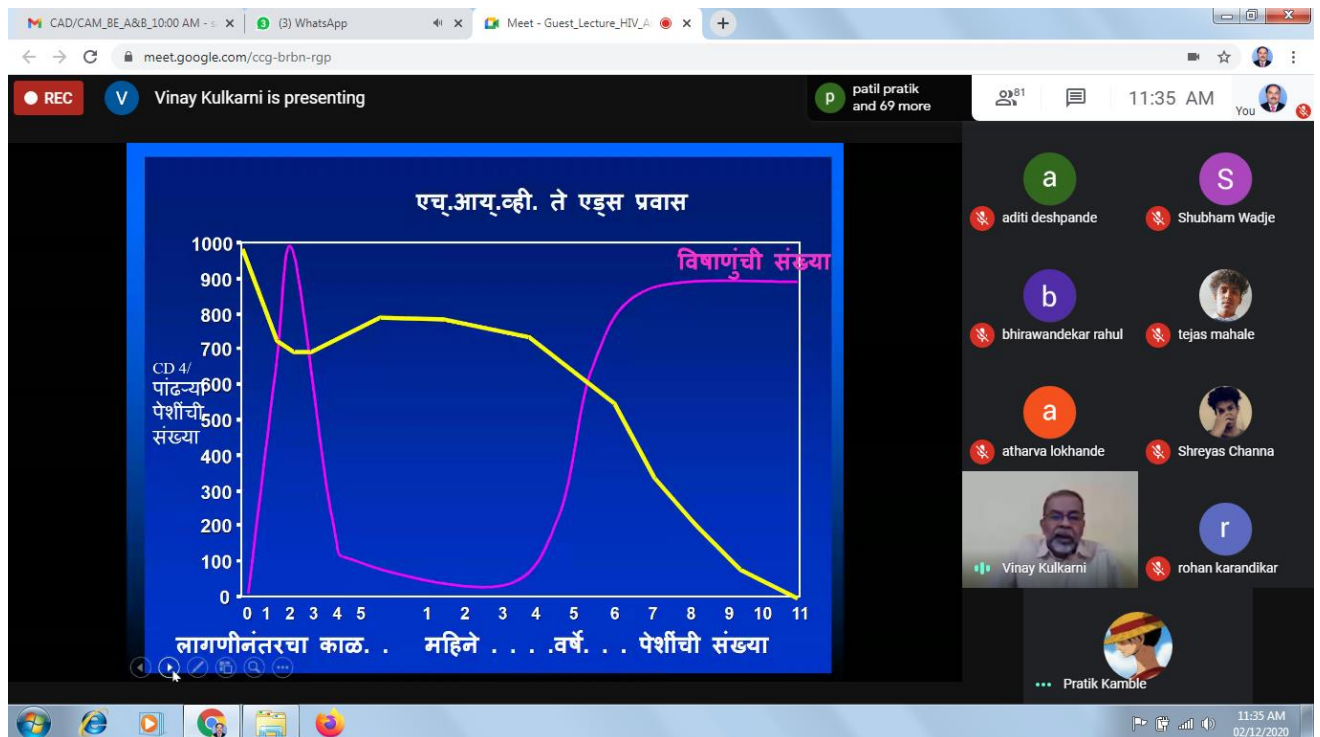
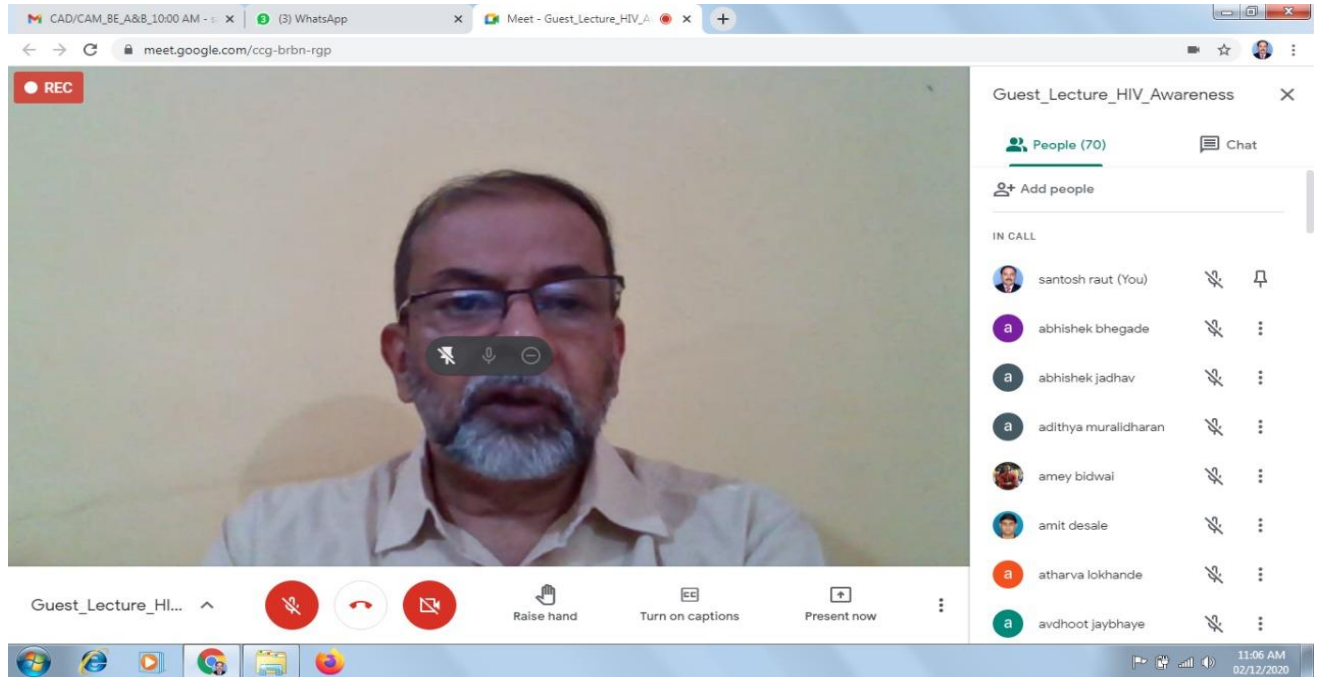


The main objective of this program was to create awareness about HIV/AIDS and its possible causes, prevention of the disease, mitigation of the impact of HIV/AIDS.

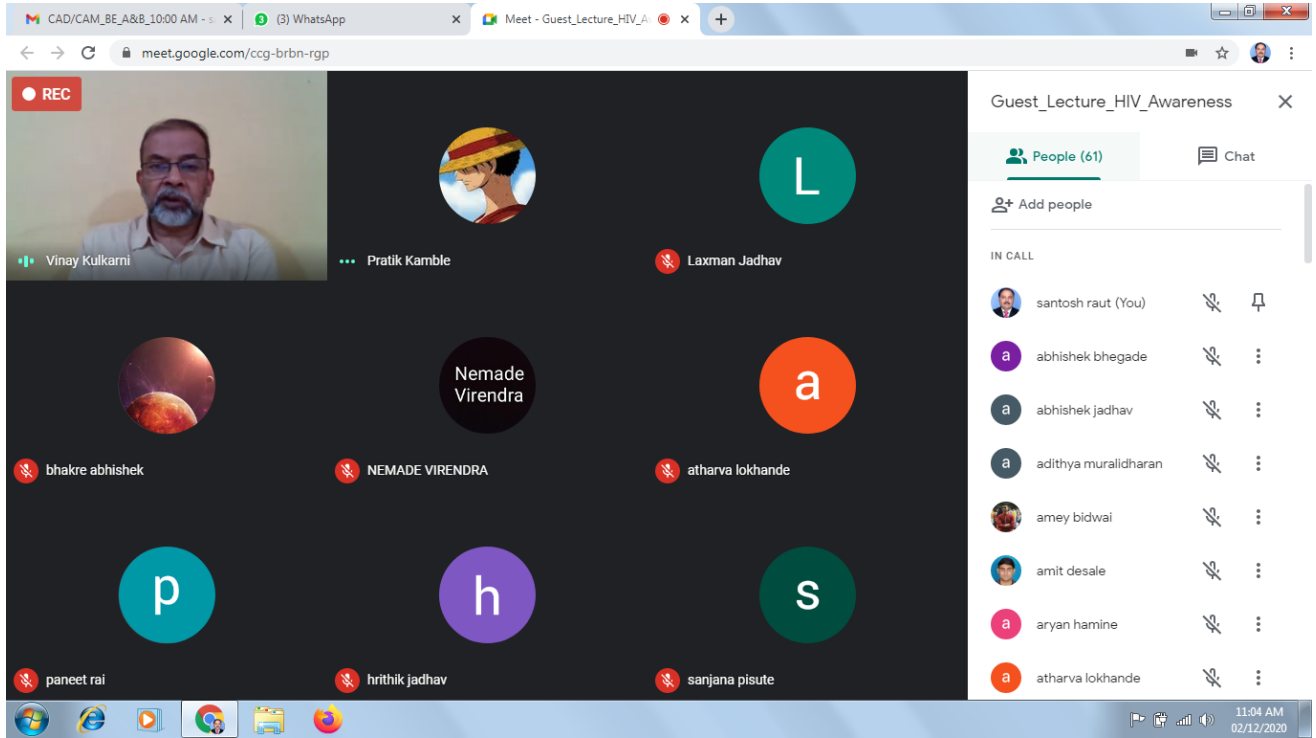

As per above theme Mrs.Rakhi Gugale a renowned Yoga practitioner was invited to teach online Yoga to our college staff and students.

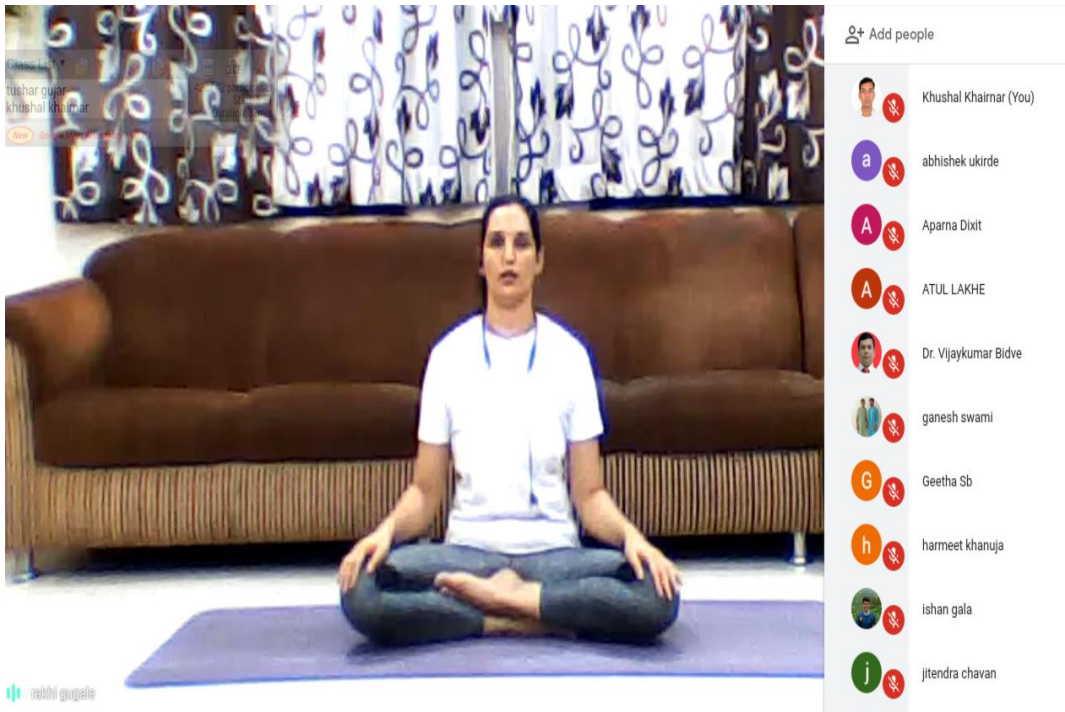
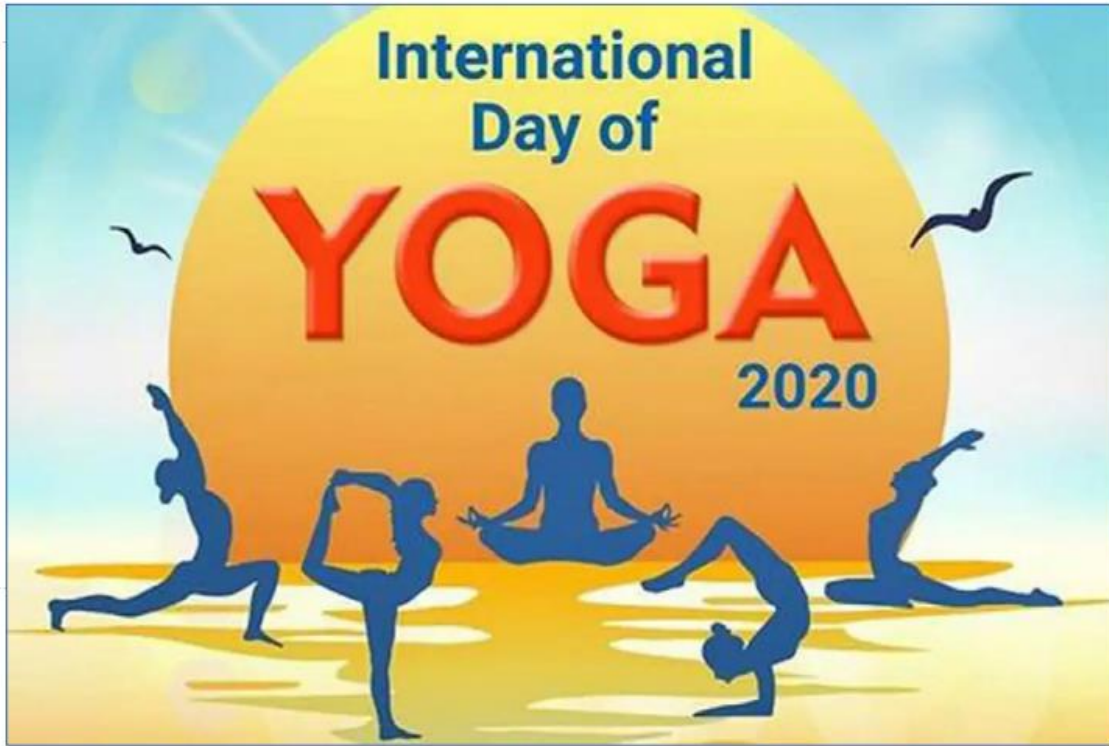
